The Allergy Department pollen collector is located on the roof at 1635 Divisadero St., San Francisco. Pollen counts are made periodically, especially during the late winter, spring and early summer, when most allergy pollen problems occur. The counts are graded into three groups: low, moderate, and high, depending on the type of pollen and the actual count. Low counts rarely produce problems. One caveat, pine pollen often appears in the counts. Pine pollen is not an important allergen; in fact it is only the rare patient who shows any reaction to this pollen.
