Changing from **Lisinopril Tablets and Hydrochlorothiazide Tablets** to **Generic Prinzide Tablets**

To help simplify your blood pressure therapy, your two prescriptions for lisinopril tablets and hydrochlorothiazide tablets have been changed to a single prescription for generic Prinzide, a combination tablet. Generic Prinzide tablets contain both medicines in one pill. This change means you will have one copayment, instead of two copayments, and one tablet to take, instead of two tablets.

Remember:

- **Do NOT take** generic Prinzide and your old lisinopril or hydrochlorothiazide tablets **at the SAME TIME.**
- Finish taking the remaining supply of your lisinopril and hydrochlorothiazide tablets **FIRST**, and then start taking generic Prinzide tablets instead.
- Follow the directions on your **NEW** generic Prinzide prescription label carefully.
- Although your medication doses have not changed, be sure to monitor your blood pressure. If your blood pressure becomes much higher than usual or you experience symptoms of low blood pressure, such as dizziness or lightheadedness, please contact your doctor.
