PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Kaiser Permanente will build a new, state-of-the-art, multi-story hospital and related facilities at #1 Quality Drive off Vaca Valley Parkway in Vacaville. The facility is being designed to meet the latest seismic safety standards and to serve the needs of the community through the year 2030 and beyond.

WHY ARE WE BUILDING A NEW HOSPITAL?

- The new hospital and related facilities are part of our long-term commitment to expand services in the North Solano Area, meeting the needs of one of the fastest growing regions in Northern California.
- The addition of the new hospital and expanded medical services will allow Kaiser Permanente to continue providing quality health care in a new state-of-the-art facility.

WHAT'S BEING BUILT?

The new hospital, medical office building and central utility plant buildings will break ground in spring 2005 and open in early 2009.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Kaiser Permanente will replace the existing hospital at 975 Sereno Drive in Vallejo with a new, state-of-the-art, multi-story facility that is being designed to meet the latest seismic safety standards and to serve the needs of the community through the year 2030 and beyond.

WHY ARE WE REPLACING THE EXISTING HOSPITAL?

- Building a new hospital and related facilities is part of our long-term commitment to serve the Napa Solano region providing quality health care services.
- State Senate Bill 1953 mandates that all California hospitals meet new, stringent seismic safety codes
- Replacement of our existing hospital building will allow us to meet the new, seismic safety requirements while providing a state-of-the art facility to serve the Napa/Solano community well into the future.

WHAT'S BEING BUILT?

The replacement hospital and related facilities are scheduled to open in mid-2008.

- New 460,000 sq.ft. Hospital Replacement Building
 - 188 New Beds Totaling 248 Bed Facility
 - Mostly Private Rooms
 - Expanded Emergency, Radiology and Surgical Services
 - Enhanced Facilities for Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Services
 - Fully Accessible for Individuals with Disabilities
 - State-of-the-Art Technology
- New 740 Vehicle Parking Structure
- New 27,000 sq.ft. Central Utility Plant
- Renovation of the 1995 Hospital Addition Building
- Renovation of the Existing Utility Plant for Support Services
- Surface Parking, Site and Landscape Upgrades
