



What is a Lentigo? This is a common type of sun-induced pigmentation, noted especially on the face, hands and arms. Some refer to these as "liver spots."

Does a Lentigo need to be removed? No therapy is recommended. Sun protection is advised to prevent darkening, enlargement and development of new ones.
