



**What is a Sebaceous Hyperplasia?** Sebaceous Hyperplasia are overactive or "overgrown" oil glands and appear as small pink-yellow-orange bumps, sometimes with a central indentation. They develop typically on the face as we age.

**Do Sebaceous Hyperplasia need to be removed?** These are completely harmless growths and have no cancerous potential. On occasion, removal is desired for cosmetic concerns. Removal is available at the Cosmetic Services Center (408) 851-8200 for a modest fee.
