



Changing from Lamotrigine Chew Tablets to Oral (Swallow) Tablets

INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

Your prescription has changed from lamotrigine (generic Lamictal) **25 mg chewable tablets** to lamotrigine **25 mg oral tablets**. Chewable and oral lamotrigine 25 mg tablets are similarly safe and effective because they both contain the *same* active ingredient, lamotrigine, in the *same* amount, 25 mg.

The only difference from the directions for your chewable lamotrigine 25 mg tablets is that your new oral lamotrigine 25 mg tablets must be swallowed and cannot be chewed.

Please remember:

- Lamotrigine 25 mg chewable tablets and lamotrigine 25 mg oral tablets contain the same medicine. **DO NOT take both of them at the SAME TIME.**
- Use up your supply of lamotrigine 25 mg chewable tablets first, then switch to the lamotrigine 25 mg oral tablets as directed. **Follow the directions on your new prescription label carefully.**
