



# Changing from Topiramate Sprinkle capsules to Oral tablets

## INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

Kaiser Permanente doctors have approved a change in medicines from topiramate (generic Topamax) **25 mg sprinkle capsules** to topiramate **25 mg oral tablets**.

Topiramate sprinkle capsules and topiramate tablets contain the *same* active ingredient, topiramate, in the *same* amount, 25 mg. They are both safe and effective.

### Tips to help you make a smooth transition

- Remember that topiramate sprinkle capsules and oral tablets are the **SAME** medicine and should **NOT** be taken together.
- Finish your supply of topiramate 25 mg sprinkle capsules first, and then start taking the oral tablets thereafter.
- Please read and follow the directions on your **new topiramate tablet prescription label** carefully.
